

Tunis, Tunisia, April 20 (Infosplusgabon) - The Tunisian Ministry of Foreign Affairs has said that it never coordinated with the Libyan interim government to organize a press conference in Tunis, a source close to the Ministry said on Saturday.

The ministry has not received any contact to coordinate or cancel a press conference, scheduled by a foreign government, It said, adding that the organization of any activity by a foreign entity must have the approval of the ministry.

Reports were received on the postponement of a press conference to be held by the Libyan Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Libyan Interim Government, Abdel Hadi Al Haouiji.

This meeting with journalists, scheduled to be held in a local hotel, was intended to take stock of the latest developments in Libya. The Libyan Ministry subsequently issued a statement in which it stated that, in view of the rapid and positive developments in Libya, the press conference is postponed.
