Bamako, Mali, October 26 (Infosplusgabon) — Heavily armed individuals suspected to be jihadists Friday attacked first and second cycle schools in Korientzé in the Mopti region of central Mali.
The attackers held teachers and their students hostage for a while and burned all school supplies before withdrawing with five teachers, a Malian government statement reaching Infosplusgabon.
The Malian government "strongly condemns this terrorist attack on these schools, which has resulted in free abuses on staff and burning of school materials that nothing can justify," the statement said.
The government also expressed its solidarity and support to teachers, parents and students whose only crime is the desire to learn and serve their country in the future.
"These obscure attacks, as cowardly as they are barbaric, will in no way undermine the will and determination of the school world to pursue its exciting mission of learning and education in the service of the Malian people of the future," the government assured the authorities.
