CAIRO, Egypt, September 15 (Infosplusgabon) -   Burundi and Sierra Leone on Friday qualified for the second round of the 2018 African Under-20 Women's World Cup Qualifying Tournament without kicking the ball.

Algeria vs Ghana First-leg 15Sept and the 2nd leg 29Sept.
